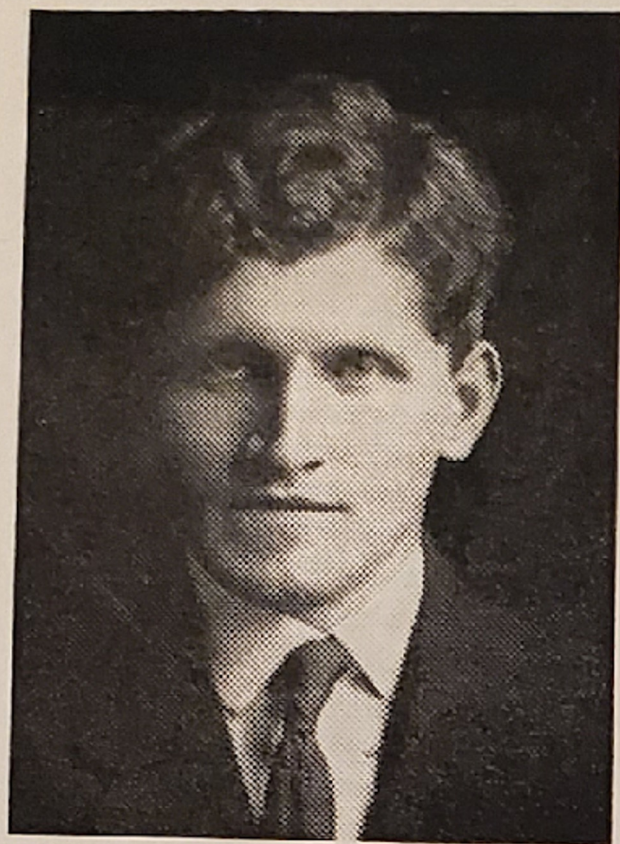

CIVIC SELF/ FREEDOM STORY

Breakout I: My Civic Story

- In the breakout groups, go around and

REFLECT FOR A MOMENT ON YOUR EARLIEST *CIVIC MEMORY*.

This could be your own discovery that you have a civic role, or it could be your discerning the civic nature of something being done by someone else (e.g., a parent or sibling or friend).

- KEY: Identify, wherever possible, concrete details that can conjure a picture of the *when, where, and what of that memory*.

Breakout II: The Experience of Freedom

- In the breakout groups, go around and

**REFLECT FOR A MOMENT ON
YOUR MOST RECENT
EXPERIENCE OF *FREEDOM*.**

Think of the last time you felt a strong sense of agency, empowerment, or authentically emancipated activity.

- AGAIN: Identify, wherever possible, concrete details that can conjure a picture of the moment for others.
